April 7 (2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter)

Scripture: Acts 1:1-14 (RCL: 1-11, Ascension, all years; 6-14, Easter 7, Year C)

Theme: Jesus' ascension

Title: "...to the ends of the earth"

What I was thinking: Acts begins where Luke ended: the disciples are with the risen Jesus, then he gives them some final instructions before leaving them.

April 14 (3rd Sunday of Easter)

Scripture: Acts 3:1-10

Theme: Peter heals in Jerusalem

Title: "Notice"

*What I was thinking:* Peter and John encounter a disabled man begging. They have no money but give him something infinitely more valuable.

April 21 (4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter) Scripture: Acts 17:1-9 Theme: The beginnings of the church in Thessalonica Title: "Turning the world upside down?" *What I was thinking:* Paul and Silas travel to Thessalonica, where they find several converts and a lot of resistance.

<u>April 28 (4th Sunday after Epiphany)</u> Scripture: Acts 18:1-4; 1 Corinthians 1:10-18 (RCL: 1 Corinthians, Epiphany 3, Year A) Theme: The start of a fractious church Title: "Has Christ been divided?" *What I was thinking:* There is something about the Corinthian church that leads Paul to have to write several times to straighten them out. What is it?

#### First Christian Church Board Meeting Minutes March 17,2024

Board members present: Deacons-Judy Daniel, Jennifer Schmehl, Peggy Thomas, Gary Coffman, Bob Thomas. Elders-John Daniel, Carol Roberts, Diana Rich, Don Malan, Shawn Quick, Chuck Lewis. Voting Member, Carol Lewis. Others present-Rev. Sharla Hulsey, Carol Ann Winburn, Phyllis McBrayer, Everett McBrayer.

Shawn Quick, Chair, called the meeting to order at 1039. He then gave the prayer.

After review with no changes or additions, the agenda was unanimously approved after a motion by Diana Rich that was seconded by Judy Daniel.

The minutes of the February 18, 2024 meeting (included in the board packet) were reviewed by the members present. A motion was made by Chuck Lewis, seconded by Diana Rich, to approve the minutes which were unanimously approved.

#### Financial Reports—

The Profit and Loss Report for February was reviewed by Carol Lewis who stated that Income for Feb. was \$6,958.37 and that Expenses were \$10,060.00. She stated that Offerings is budgeted at \$11,179.00 for the month and we received \$6,778.00. We are still ahead year to date but that won't continue if Offerings remain below the budgeted amount. She also mentioned that the "Ketchup" fund is at \$3,728.00. The Balance Sheet was reviewed with the notation that a donation of \$245.00 was received for the Outreach Fund. A motion to accept the Financial Reports was made by Chuck Lewis, seconded by Diana Rich and approved unanimously.

#### Minister's Report—

Reverend Hulsey reported that she had to miss several meetings in Feb. due to assorted appointments and illness. She did have several phone calls, text messages and in-person conversations and attended the Disciples Women group and the Elders meeting. She continues with her daily morning prayers on Facebook Live and has participated in the weekly Lenten services. Next Lenten service is Wed, March 20 for which Rev. Hulsey will give the sermon. Good Friday services are scheduled for March 29 at 5:30 at the Ohio Street Methodist Church.

#### OLD BUSINESS-

North Wall—Chuck Lewis asked if "Anyone noticed?" The north wall has been painted! Carol Roberts noticed some bubbling in one area, but Chuck stated that the painter had left the remaining unused paint so we can patch if we need to. But Chuck stated that this project is done !

Kitchen mats—Everett stated that someone had left 2 small mats in the kitchen. Jennifer Schmehl stated that she was able to get them at such a low price that she bought them to be used temporarily until appropriate sized mats could be obtained. Sharla said she would check to see if we could find some online.

There being no further business, John Daniel made the motion to adjourn, seconded by Gary Coffman, unanimously approved. Meeting adjourned at 1105.
